B. POLICY AND IMPORTANT ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS.

BOG-87(2022)-05: To consider and approve the faculty recruitment process for the recruitment year 2022-23.

The Institute has 485 sanctioned faculty positions across the levels of Assistant Professors, Associate Professors, and Professors. There are 141 vacancies available across the above cadres among

all the 20 departments. A detailed table containing the department wise faculty distribution sheet, proposed cadre strength for all five cadres, vacancy break-up for upcoming faculty recruitment, proposed faculty strength, reservation register for five faculty cadres, list of expert nominee for various departments, list of observers for SC/ST and minor community and department-wise specialization related to faculty recruitment 2022 is attached in the Annexure .

Further, the ministry letter referring to Clause 7, Vide No. F.No.33-3/2018 – T.S.III, dated 05/11/2019, directs that: "All the NITs and IEST, Shibpur are requested to implement the provisions of the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act, 2019 (10 of 2019) immediately in the manner specified in Office Memorandum, No. 36039/12019-Est/(Res.) of the Department of Personnel and Training dated 31st January 2019, to the extent mentioned in Gazette Notification dated 12th July 2019." The details of the CEI Act 2019 are attached in the Annexure.

Given the above, the vacant faculty positions must be notified to fill up all the vacancies. This matter was earlier placed in the 86th BOG dated 29-09-2022 and the Board advised the Institute to place it in the next meeting with the revised reservation roster.

Shri S. K. Upadhyay joined as Registrar, NIT, Rourkela, on 01.04.2004. His tenure was extended on 21.02.2005, 27.02.2006, 08.03.2007, and 29.12.2008. His last tenure was extended up to 28.12.2018. In terms of Statute-24 (vi) and Statute 29 of the First Statutes of NIT, he was governed under NPS.

Mr. Upadhyay retired from Institute Service on superannuation w.e.f. 28/12/2018. His request for payment of gratuity could not be extended due to instruction of the Ministry of Education vide F. No. 14-1/2019-TS. III, dated 03/04/2019.

Due to denial of payment of gratuity, he moved to the Regional Labour Commissioner (Central), Rourkela, where the Controlling Authority ordered the Institute to pay the gratuity (₹ 17,75,232/-) with interest (₹ 3,95,415/-) to Mr. Upadhyay under the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972.

Consequently, the Institute filed an appeal before Dy. Chief Labour Commissioner (DCLC), Bhubaneswar, against the order of RLC, Rourkela. After hearing both sides, the Appellate Authority issued an order upholding the order of the Controlling Authority to release the gratuity.

Further, the Controlling authority on 18.08.2022 asked the Institute management to intimate whether the management has moved to any higher court or authority against the appeal order of the Appellate authority so that the controlling authority can take necessary action for payment of gratuity to Shri S. K. Upadhyay, which is lying with the appellate authority.

Regarding the above, the Institute took the Ministry's advice through letter no. NITR/RG/2022/L/0507, dated 26.08.2022, on this issue.

The MoE vide letter no. F.No.14-8/2022-TS.III, dated 07.09.2022, directed the Institute to extend the gratuity benefit to Shri S.K. Upadhyay. Accordingly, RLC Rourkela was informed by the Institute vide letter no. NITR/RG/2022/M/0559 dated 08-09-2022




to take the necessary steps to extend the gratuity benefit to Shri S.K Upadhyay at the earliest.

BOG-87(2022)-11: Revision of Hostel Seat rent of Rosysmita Bikram Singh, Roll No. 519CE1006, Ph. D. research scholar.

Rosysmita Bikram Singh, Roll No. 519CE1006, a Ph. D. research scholar, Civil Engineering Department, has given a representation that she is paying full hostel seat rent as per the prevailing rate of @Rs.5000/- per semester.

Rosysmita Bikram Singh, in her representation, stated that her husband, Mr. Avinash Samantray, Roll No. 519CS1003, a Ph.D. research scholar from Comp. Science Department of the Institute also pays the establishment and seat rent fee @Rs.12,000/- per semester, even though they possess the same accommodation, which is double the fee for the same accommodation.

Although both Ph.D. scholars on marriage occupy single/same accommodation but both are charged seat rent fee/semester individually as per the BOG vide resolution no. BOG-60(2018)-21, dated 22.06.2018, clause no.8. (enclosed in the Annexure). Dean (AC) has also stated that though the claim from the Ph.D. scholar seems logical, BOG approval is needed to amend the fee structure.

SAIL-BSL and NIT Rourkela agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined and agreed upon separately by the two parties. This MoU has no financial implication on each other.


