Developing modules for child protection functionaries through developmental and life skills lens with specific focus on mental health and psychosocial care of children in child care institutions. An overall child protection module with the aim of sensitization and capacity building of functionaries and other stakeholders is being aimed to be developed through this term. d. Work with DWCD in convergence and coordination with other line departments such as Police/Home Department, Health, Education and other concerned departments to strengthen psychosocial and mental health support of children. e. Developing experiential methods of learning of child protection functionaries to work with children with special focus on life skills f. Undertake research alongside the domain of child protection with special focus on alternative care methods to ensure creation
