**POLICY ON SELECTION OF BEST POSTERS IN RESEARCH SCHOLARS' WEEK**

Starting with the Research Scholars' Week – 2019, following policy will be followed for selection of the Best Posters of RSW.

1. Instead of 3 prizes across all departments there will be separate 5 prizes for the PA and 12 Engineering departments, 2 prizes for the 5 Science departments and 1 prize for the HS and SM together.
2. There will be four stages of evaluation as follows:-
  - A. Evaluation of Abstracts at Department level (average a panel) - 20 marks
  - B. Evaluation of Posters [Stage – I] (average of a panel) - 40 marks
  - C. Evaluation of Posters [Stage – II] (average of a panel) - 20 marks
  - D. Oral Presentation (average of a panel) - 20 marks

3. Selection to next stage will be as follows:-

Stage	Engineering	Science	HS & SM
A	All those who submitted Abstract will be evaluated		
A to B	All those who submitted Abstract will also present Poster and be evaluated		
B to C	Best two (one if number of posters are up to 7) of each department subject to minimum score of 35 marks out of 60 (i.e. 20 of Stage – A + 40 of Stage – B)		
C to D	Best 10*	Best 5*	Best 3*
Prize	Best 5^	Best 2^	Best 1^

\* Subject to scoring minimum 13 out of 20 in Stage – C.

^ Subject to scoring minimum 15 out of 20 in Stage – D and minimum 65 out of 100 overall.

4. In case of tie of marks for recommendation to Stage – C and to Stage – D, all scholars having the same score will be recommended to the respective next stage.
5. There will be separate Panel of Evaluators for Engineering, Science and HS & SM as there will be separate prize for these three categories.

6. Composition of the panel of evaluators will be as follows:-

Stage	Engineering	Science	HS & SM
A	2 faculty from respective department		
B	2 faculty from respective department		
C	Panel of 7 (1 each from 7 departments)	Panel of 5 (1 each from 5 departments)	Panel of 4 (2 from HS & 2 from SM)
D	Panel of 6 (1 each from rest 6 departments)	Panel of 5 (1 each from 5 departments)	Panel of 4 (2 from HS & 2 from SM)

7. Panels for Stage – A and B will be constituted by Dean (AC) in consultation with at least two members of the Core Committee and Panels for Stage – C and D will be recommended by the Dean (AC) in consultation with at least two members of the Core Committee and approved by the Director.
8. Best Poster of the department will be chosen out of 80 (A+B+C) if no or only one poster from the department is recommended to Stage-D and will be chosen out of 100 (A+B+C+D) if more than one poster from the department are recommended to Stage-D.
9. Recommendation for Best Posters will be decided based on total score out of 100 and in case of tie, based on total score up to Stage – C and in case of further tie, based on total score up to Stage – B.
10. Scholars who can not remain physically present during RSW have also to submit their Abstract as well as Poster. Poster/Oral Presentation may be done by some other scholar on his/her behalf (to be arranged by the scholar) or may be waived by Dean (AC) considering merit of each case.
11. Issues not covered in these guidelines will be decided by the Director.
