Guidelines for Abstract/Paper Submission

The abstract should reflect the whole paper including **context**, **objectives**, **methodology and main conclusions**. Abstracts/ full papers, approximately of 300 and 6000 words, should be sent electronically to the conference convener (Email: jpp.pradhan@gmail.com/jpp_pradhan@yahoo.co.uk). After initial screening, selected submissions will be peer reviewed and finalized for publication. All selected papers will be **published in an edited book volume.**The following guidelines can be used while formatting your full paper.

Guidelines:

- 1. All full papers should be submitted in word format with 1.5 line spacing. We strongly recommend full papers not exceeding 30 pages. The suggested length reference lists, figures, and tables should follow standard APA style. Authors are encouraged to adhere as closely as possible to APA style. Excessively long submissions may be summarily rejected.
- 2. Please use **12-point Times New Roman or similar font**. Margins should be 1.5 inches on the top, bottom, and sides.

- 3. Your paper should include a title page with each author's name and contact information.
- 4. Include an abstract of **300** or fewer words.
- 5. Include paper of **6000** or fewer words.
