**BOG-34(2011)-06: Review of filling up of the posts under reserve category in respect of SC/ST and OBC in employment and admission.**

The Secretary, MHRD, Govt. of India, vide letter No.D O No 21-64/2012- consider the present status and give necessary guide line for filling up of posts under reserve category in future.

Chairman, BOG expressed concern regarding the vacancy in reserved category and the observation of the Standing Parliamentary Committee as mentioned by the Secretary, MHRD. The present position of both student and staff was presented before the BOG. The BOG directed that the vacancy positions both in Teaching and Non-Teaching positions may be advertised and the posts be filled up immediately.

The Board advised the administration that a letter will be sent to the Ministry giving suggestions for filling up of SC/ST backlog in the student category. The following was suggested:

- 1) Special recruitment drive for filling up backlog vacancies of SC/ST & OBC will be taken up immediately.
- 2) Fresh advertisement will be made for filling up the posts sanctioned recently.
- 3) Introduction of slow pace programme based on the results in AIEEE/ JEE, NIT Council will be requested for introduction of preparatory and slow pace courses for weak students.
- 4) A campaign will be made to attract research students in the Institute for generating potential faculty personnel in reserved categories.



**Subject: Restructuring of Non-faculty and faculty Cadres in NITs - Creation of posts - regarding.**

Sir,

The proposal of National Institute of Technology-Rourkela regarding creation of faculty posts has been examined in consultation with the Integrated Finance Division in this Ministry. The actual students' strength of the Institute for the year 2012-13 is 4431. In accordance with the student: faculty ratio of 12:1, the entitlement of faculty posts for NIT-Rourkela is 369. The present approved faculty strength of the Institute is 281. Further, in accordance with the existing instructions, the faculty: non-faculty ratio of NITs is 1:1.1. The entitlement of non-faculty posts for the Institute is 406 and the total non-faculty posts in position are 309. The corresponding non-faculty strength is, therefore, being revised to 406. In view of the above, sanction of the competent authority is hereby conveyed for the creation of additional Eighty Eight (88) faculty posts and Ninety Seven (97) non-faculty posts as mentioned below:-

2. It is clarified that the total faculty posts should not exceed the total entitlement of the Institute i.e. Professor-53, Associate Professor-106 and Asstt. Prof.-210 (Total = 369), as a result of the creation of the above mentioned 88 faculty posts. It is also advised that while actually filling up the additional faculty posts being sanctioned, the temporary arrangement made in respect of visiting faculty etc. should be discontinued.

The uniform RR's are at present with the Ministry of Law & Justice for vetting before its Notification/Publication in the Official Gazette. Any modification in the RR's will be notified in Official Gazette. The Institute is advised to take into account the final Notified Uniform Recruitment Rules before the final recruitment of the Faculty and Non-faculty positions.

4. The total faculty and non-faculty posts of the Institute should not exceed its total entitlement i.e. 369 and 406 respectively as a result of the creation of additional 88 faculty and 97 non-faculty posts as mentioned above.



Dear Shri Chandra,

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Welfare of Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes in its meeting held on 9.1.2013 reviewed the position obtaining in respect of SC/ST reservation in employment and admission in higher educational institutions under the purview of this Ministry. The Committee expressed its deep concern over the abysmally low representation of these categories in employment, particularly at faculty level in almost all Centrally Funded Technical Institutions, except the NITs. Even in regard to enrolment of students, it was observed by the Committee that we are still falling behind the quota of 10% and 7 1/2 % fixed for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, respectively. The Committee was at pains to point out that reservation for SCs/STs are constitutional obligations and the same ought to be implemented faithfully by all concerned. The Parliamentary Standing Committee in its above meeting observed that these institutions which are not serious about implementing the constitutional obligation, their funding may be considered to be stopped by MHRD. The next meeting of the Standing Committee is likely to be held shortly.

2 In view of above, I thought it fit to share my personal concern as well with you. Under the circumstances you may consider convening a special meeting of the Board of Governors so as to review the policy presently being followed by the Institute, as also to firm up necessary steps for implementing the reservation policy, in letter and spirit, both for employment and admission in terms of the executive instructions issued from time to time by the Department of Personnel and Training and this Ministry. The Board of Governors may also review the action taken so far by the Institute in pursuance of the Special Drives for filling up of backlog vacancies launched at the behest of Department of Personnel and Training as also submissions of the periodic reports/returns presented in this regard.

3 As regards SC/ST students' enrolment, which is still below the desired level, it may perhaps be appropriate to consider following, with necessary modification, if any, the kind of a 'Preparatory Course' that is being conducted by the IIT system which has salutary effect in improving the intake of students from reserved categories.

4 I am sure, you would appreciate the sensitivity and the constitutional obligation cast upon all of us in this regard and will place the entire matter before Board of Governors for deliberation and appropriate action at an early date. I shall be grateful if you could apprise me of the action taken.

- (i) NITs where the post of Registrar is currently being operated by assigning the duties of Registrar to a faculty member, the same may be got filled up as per these Recruitment Rules;
- (ii) In cases where the post of Registrar is being operated by appointment on contract or deputation, the existing contract or deputation, if the same do not comply with


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the fresh Recruitment Rules, may be got terminated and fresh appointments made as per the Recruitment Rules as framed now;

- (iii) In cases where the post of Registrar is being operated by non faculty on temporary basis, the Institute may initiate the process of appointment of Registrar as per fresh Recruitment Rules;
- (iv) In cases where the existing incumbent to the post of Registrar is already recruited as such, they may be given the revised scale of pay of Rs. 16400-22400 subject to their possessing the required qualification and experience;

The contents of the Recruitment Rules framed by MHRD for the post of Registrar and the course of action suggested in para as above, may be brought to the notice of the Board of Governors for further action. As the appointment of Registrar as per Section 24 (a) of the National Institutes of Technology Act 2007 is within the purview of the Board of Governors, further action in this matter is required to be taken by the BoG of the concerned NITs.

1. **Short title and commencement:-** (1) These Rules may be called the National Institutes of Technology (NITs), (Registrar) Recruitment Rules, 2008.  
  
(2) These shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Definitions:-** In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires;
  - (a) "Act" means National Institutes of Technology Act, 2007.
  - (b) "Registrar" means the Registrar of a National Institute of Technology (NIT).
3. **Method of Recruitment and other matters:-** The method of recruitment and other matters relating to the post of Registrar shall be as specified in columns 1 to 7 of the Schedule annexed to these Rules.
4. **Disqualification - No person,**
  - (i) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
  - (ii) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rules.


