Proposal for revised student fee structure.

On the recommendation of FC vide No. FC15(2010)-09, the BOG vide resolution BOG-26(2011)-06, dt.17.06.2011 had approved the composite student fee structure, from the academic session 2011-12 for B.Tech / M.Tech./ MBA/ M.Sc./ MA/ Ph.D./ M.Tech.(Res.) Programmes.

In the financial year 2011-12, it is observed that the Medical expenditure for the students are as follows:

i. Medical Expenditure for students:

iii) Deficit (i) - (ii) = Rs.37,19,016/-

Thus there is a deficit of amount Rs. 37,19,016/- (Rupees thirty seven lakhs nineteen thousand sixteen only) and out of Rs.1500/-collected from students, Rs.552/- is spent towards insurance premium and the balance money is spent for medical expenditure. The student strength in the current academic year stands close to 4500. The medical expenditure will accordingly go up. Therefore it is proposed to increase medical fee from Rs.1500 to Rs.2000 per annum from the academic year 2012 -2013. The Institute will review the continuation of insurance at the end of current financial year.

A composite student fee structure is given on the Table for approval of FC and BOG. In addition to incorporation of revised medical fee. Few other items, e.g. hostel admission fee. Book fee and thesis processing fee have been rationalized.

Note:

 Tuition fee and all other fees except the one time fees will be collected in two equal installments during Semester registration.

2) Tuition fee of SC/ST students taking admission in all postgraduate (except MBA) and

research programmes will be born by the Institute.

3) Students provided with family accommodation in institute quarters (if any) will be attached to a hall for married students. They will pay seat rent at the higher rate of S.S. Bhatnagar Hall of Residence.

4) Hostel seat rent (except that for family accommodation) includes electricity charges up to 50 units per student per month, average. Excess consumption will be billed extra,

uniformly for all the students of the hall.

Tuition fees and development fees can be borne by research projects in case of students of all categories, if the student's research activity has a bearing on the project.

- Medical fee will entitle the student to free treatment and medicines at the Institute Health Centre, plus insurance cover against hospitalization if such a scheme is adopted by the Institute.
- 7) Students are required to pay fees during all the semesters (or part thereof). They are in the roll of the Institute from admission till thesis submission.
- 8) Institute employees enrolled in M.Tech.(Res.) or Ph.D. Programme are exempted from paying all fees except admission fee and examination fee.
- 9) Foreign students coming under different schemes will pay tuition fee at a rate fixed under the scheme, instead of the rate given above.
- 10) Ph. D., M.Tech.(Res) and M.Tech. Students who are granted withdrawal are exempted from paying fee under Medical fees and hostel fees.
 - 1) A student permitted to stay outside the halls at his own request shall pay full seat rent and establishment fee for the hall he is attached to.
- 12) The seat rent chargeable to students who have taken withdrawal during short term visit to the institute shall be 10 % of annual rent for each month (30 days) or part there of
- 13) When persons other than students are given hostel accommodation, they will pay seat rent at the same rate as for students, but on 6 monthly basis, payable at entry, in January and in July, irrespective of their date of entry. Every payment amount shall be 50% of annual seat rent.
- 14) Candidates for D.Sc. Degree will pay thesis evaluation fee equal to that for Ph.D students.
- 15) B.Tech/ Dual Degree (B.Tech & M.Tech)/ M.Sc./MA/ M. Tech and MBA students will be given coupons to buy books of their choice against the book fee paid at the beginning of every semester.
- Semester fees shall normally be payable at the time of Pre-registration, which is done in the previous semester or at the time of admission. Delayed payment will attract penalty which may be waived in case of students awaiting receipt of scholarships or Bank Loans till. Semester registration date, but not beyond.

17) If a student fails to submit thesis within one month of acceptance of synopsis by the Academic Office, the thesis processing fee needs to be paid again.
