Senate-98[2021]-01: Welcome to the members and invitees

Director and Chairman, Senate welcomed all members and invitees to the 98th meeting of the Senate conducted in online mode through MS-TEAM.

A. RULES, PROCEDURES, CURRICULA AND POLICY MATTERS

Senate-98[2021]-04: Academic calendar after completion of online theory classes

It was decided by the Senate vide Resolution No. Senate-96[2020]-03 that the Autumn and Spring semesters for all UG 1st year students will commence from Dec 1st, 2020 and 1st March, 2021 respectively. The duration of each of these two semesters shall be reduced from 80 to 65 working days. However, due to last minute extension of counselling, the classes of UG 1st semester started from Dec. 7th, 2020 (Monday). For all other programmes, Spring semester commenced from Dec 14th, 2020 and it

will also be for a duration of 65 working days. Accordingly, the classes of Autumn semester of UG 1st semester and Spring semester of rest of the courses shall be over on March 5th and 12th, respectively.

So, it was proposed to start theory classes of Spring semester of UG 1st year through online mode from March 8th, 2021 (Monday). However, for rest of the courses, decision needs to be taken for future course of action after March 12th in view of risk of calling the students back to campus under the prevailing situations of covid19 pandemic.

After detailed deliberation, the Senate decided to constitute a Committee consisting of the following members to submit its recommendation to Chairman, Senate:

✓ Senate-98[2021]-05: Semester registration of Ph.D students admitted in January 2021.

The admission process for PhD and Executive PhD programme for Spring 2020-21 has concluded in the third week of January 2021. As per existing Academic Regulations, the semester registration should be completed within 30 calendar days from the scheduled date of registration. However, due to COVID pandemic, the registration of Spring semester of AY 2020-21 was scheduled on 13th Dec, 2020 instead of usual date of registration on 1st January, 2021. As a special case it was decided in 212th meeting of Deans and HODs held on 27/01/2021, to allow registration of Course work in Spring semester 2020-21 latest by 31st Jan, 2021 subject to subsequent ratification in Senate meeting.

The Senate approved the recommendation of 212th meeting of Deans and HODs.

√Senate-98[2021]-06: Effective date of enrollment of 1st batch of Executive PhD students.

The admission of 1st batch of Executive PhD students (2019 batch) was completed in the month of November 2019. The programme being lunched for the first time, it could not be executed from Autumn 2019-20 and due to addition of this new programme in NITRIS portal, the course work could be started only from January 2020. The semester fee of Autumn semester was adjusted as that of Spring semester. Hence, it was proposed that the enrollment date for all 1st batch student of the programme shall deemed to be effective from 01-01-2020.

Item-5: Finalization of dates for End Semester examination.

The Senate vide resolution no. Senate-96[2020]-04 has decided that (i) End Semester Examination will be conducted only after the students return to campus physically. There should be gap of at least 2 weeks between starting of exams and their return to campus, (ii) End Semester Exams for Autumn and Spring Semesters can be held with a gap of at least 2 weeks at least (not continuously). As it has already been decided that the final year UG students are supposed to return to the campus by 12th March 2121, the detail proposal for starting Lab courses and End semester examination for both Autumn and Spring Semester 2020-21 is annexed for consideration of the senate.
