Research Methodology Course (RMC)

There is no doubt about the centrality of social science research. It is pervasive and affects our daily life. It is highly relevant for understanding social life and to the decisions we make each day. It answers to questions and solutions to problems. It seeks to find explanations to unexplained phenomena, and to correct the misconceived facts.

An understanding of social research methodology is vital for various reasons. For instance, it will help young researcher scholars to avoid many pitfalls at the selection of research strategies, methods and data collection practices.

A training on research methodology is necessary to equip budding researchers with methodological skills, as they are lacking such skills there or are inadequate skill building exercises. A training on research methods is also important to ensure that the correct procedures are followed, and for gaining an appreciation of the choices that are available to young researchers. The training will also help to maintain high quality academic standards and research outputs.

Aim of the course

The aim of the course is to improve the research methodological and writing skills of the budding/ young scholars and enhance their ability to undertake research as promising social scientists/ researchers. The programme will provide an in-depth understanding of social research strategies including qualitative, quantitative and mixed methods/ approaches, research designs, design of questionnaire, sampling, statistical techniques, data analysis and interpretation, and elements of academic writing (research proposal, report, etc.).

Eligibility Criteria for the Course

The Research Scholars enrolled for M. Phil / Ph.D. / PDF in Social Sciences in Indian Universities/Institutes will be eligible to apply/participate in the course.

Research Scholars interested to attend the Research Methodology Course should:

- 1. Fill the requisite Application Form attached below and get it forwarded by his/her Research Supervisor and Head of the Department.
- 2. Also submit the following along with the application form:
 - a. A copy of updated CV.
 - b. A note on the current status of their research work.
 - c. Motivation plan and Expected benefits from attending the programme
- 3. Submission of Application
 - Send the Scan/Soft Copies of duly filled and forwarded application form and requisite documents (in a single PDF) to the Co-Course Director through e-mail at kkorao@gmail.com
- 4. Hard copy of the application (and attachments) must also be submitted on joining the course in case of selection without which candidates may not be allowed to participate in the course.
- 5. If the application is incomplete or not forwarded/recommended by the Supervisor and the HoD, it may be summarily rejected.
- 6. Applications received after the deadline won't be considered.

Number of Seats

The number of seats is limited to 30, of which 20 seats are for out station and 10 for local participants. The details are as follows:

- Ten (10) for the Scholars from outside the state of Odisha (they will be selected from all over India),
- Ten (10) for the Scholars from within the state of Odisha, and
- Ten (10) for the Scholars from the city of Rourkela.

Training Methodology

- The programme will consist of lectures by eminent scholars and senior social scientists, hands-on exercises by the participants, practical sessions on computers, interactive (question-answer) sessions, library work, research practice (fieldwork), report writing, and presentations. Participants will be provided with necessary materials/e-resources.
- All the selected participants are requested to bring their laptops with them for the practical sessions and research practice, and for deriving maximum benefits from the Research Methodology Course.

Resource Persons

Resource persons shall be eminent Professors/Researchers having expertise and vast experience in their respective areas from Institutes of repute.

Duration of the Programme

The duration of course is of **Ten Days** and scheduled to be held during **21st – 30th** April 2023.

Course/ Registration Fee

There is no fee.

Travel Cost

- Outstation participants are eligible for sleeper class train or actual bus fare in the shortest route to and fro.
- Reimbursement shall be made only on submission/production of confirmed train tickets or original bus tickets.
- No local conveyance would be reimbursed.
- Taxi, Own Car Mileage, Auto, Air Fare shall not be admissible under any circumstances.

Accommodation

Free accommodation will be provided to all outstation participants in the NITR Guest House (North Block) on double sharing basis during programme.

Local hospitality

- Local participants (outside the NITR) would be provided only lunch and tea/snacks during the programme break.
